



Over the past few months there has been a lot of uncertainty while planning for this event. With careful planning and collaboration, we've made many major changes and added new guidelines to be able to offer a safe and fun volleyball experience for all participants.

Extended Refund Period

If you have any reservations about traveling, playing or attending, please stay home. We have extended our refund period and will offer full refunds until the day before the tournament you are registered for.

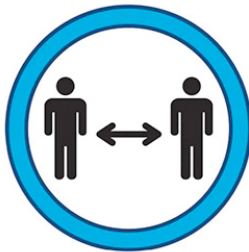
We've consulted with Brighton Acres, the Oshkosh Convention & Visitor's Bureau, the Winnebago County Health Department and the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office to come up with the following changes, rules and guidelines.

- We've capped the weekend at less than 50% capacity to allow for more free space around the courts and grounds. Having more room will make it easier for people to practice distancing guidelines.
- We've eliminated camping, as well as the shower trailer.
- We've eliminated the need for check-in lines. Captains will be sent an email the day before the event with a check-in button in it. This will allow your team to go directly to your court upon arrival.
- We're not charging for parking, this will avoid any cash transactions and speed up the parking process.
- The entire event will be outdoors. We will not have access to the Brighton Acres buildings for any reason.
- First Aid will be available for emergencies and necessary treatments only. No massages or preventative wraps. Anyone that visits the trainers must be wearing a mask.
- We've eliminated the Championship Court area and celebration. We've removed the grand stands, national anthem, fireworks, DJ and band. The Open semi-finals and finals will be streamed online as an alternative to watching in person.
- We've eliminated the commemorative stein and refillable cups.

- We're discouraging spectators. Parents of junior players are an exception. If you come out, please come prepared with a mask and follow the distancing/protective measures below.
If you are playing at The Bar - Oshkosh:
 - Adult Tournaments: no spectators are allowed during adult tournaments.
 - Juniors Tournaments: each junior player is allowed to have 1 adult accompany them.
Wristbands will be given during check-in.
- We're adding more hand wash stations and sanitizer dispensers around the grounds. In addition, we ask that you bring your own wipes, sanitizer, masks and other preventative supplies.

GUIDELINES

Most Important Rule: Stay home if you are sick or do not feel well.

Practice Physical Distancing and Protective Measures, including the following:

- Maintain physical distancing of six (6) feet or more between your team/group and others. We have spaced out courts and provided twice as much room for people to setup their pop-up tents.
- Minimize time spent with anyone outside your group;
- Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol;
- Cover coughs or sneezes (into the sleeve or elbow, not hands) and then hand wash or sanitize;
- Avoid handshaking, hand slapping and hugging;
- Use a mask or cloth face covering, especially where it is difficult to maintain physical distancing;

Zero-Tolerance: If anyone abuses these guidelines, or behaves in a reckless manner, they will be asked to leave the grounds.
